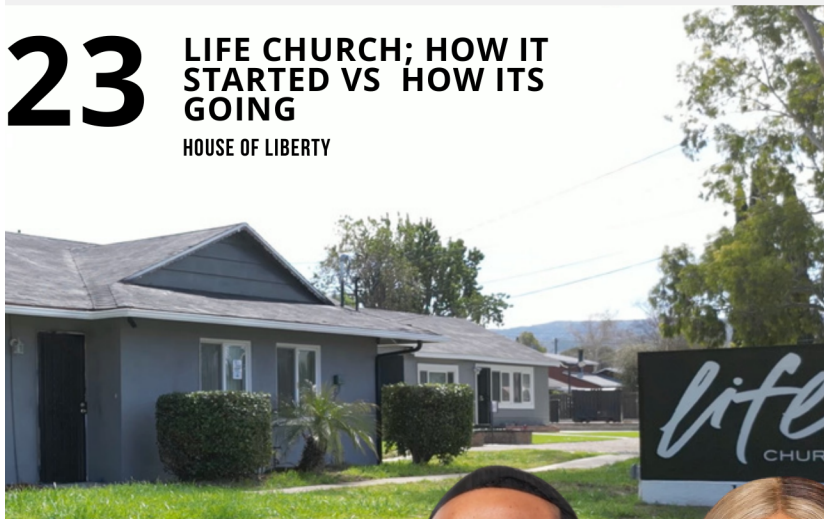

# MANIFESTS

When many people consider the concept of manifestation, they often associate it with the Laws of Attraction. However, in the context of biblical manifestation, it is demonstrated in various ways. For instance, the encounter of Moses with the burning bush was a manifestation from God, revealing His presence.

The term "manifestation" is derived from the root word "manifest," which signifies that something is clear, apparent, and easily visible both to the eye and to one's comprehension. It means that it is understandable and not hidden or challenging to grasp.

Manifestation can also take the form of truth. This month, my goal is to help as many people as possible understand and experience manifestation, and to guide them in manifesting more of God in their lives. Manifesting not just wealth, but everything we need in our lives, is crucial. The reality and a significant aspect of manifestation is that it largely depends on our perspective and how we perceive things.

When we sow a seed into the soil of our hearts, we trust that it will flourish and transform into what we are believing it to be. We have confidence that it will develop without the need for us to continually dig it up to check on its progress. We simply have faith in the inherent potential of the seed and in the actions we've taken.

We must still ensure that we have planted the seed in the right soil, watered it appropriately, and fertilized it with our words of faith. That is our responsibility. We must trust in the potential of the seed and the actions we've taken in planting it. By doing so, we can be confident in its manifestation, and we should refrain from digging up the seed again, maintaining our faith that it will grow.



# MANIFESTATION

If we were to dig up the seed, we would disrupt its manifestation and growth. Often, we do this in our own lives. We fail to believe in the seed we have planted, thereby limiting its potential to break forth and manifest. We doubt the words with which we water the seed, lacking faith. We wait for someone else to come and nurture our seed, but that's our responsibility. We should be watering our seed with words of faith spoken from our mouths. When we plant our seed in fertile ground and release it, we must then nourish it with words of faith from our mouths.

Truth can manifest in various forms. It may come through your prophet, a dream, a vision from God, or even a visitation. All these are forms of manifestation. However, when we water it with our doubts and lack belief, it's like digging up the seed we planted, and as a result, we will never witness its true manifestation.

When we receive the word through any of these channels and doubt it, we won't experience the manifestation. None of us are perfect; it's all a learning process. I've made this mistake myself when I was younger, mainly because I didn't believe in myself. I didn't believe in the God within me. I didn't believe that I was made in His image and likeness. Simply put, I just didn't believe!

We have to detach ourselves from the outcome. I must admit that's very hard to do. We have to stop trying to force it and walk by faith and not by sight. We have to perceive our outcome in our heart and realize that everything is happening for you and not to you. We simply have to know that in our hearts. It is important to attach your belief to scripture.

*Proverbs 3:5-7*

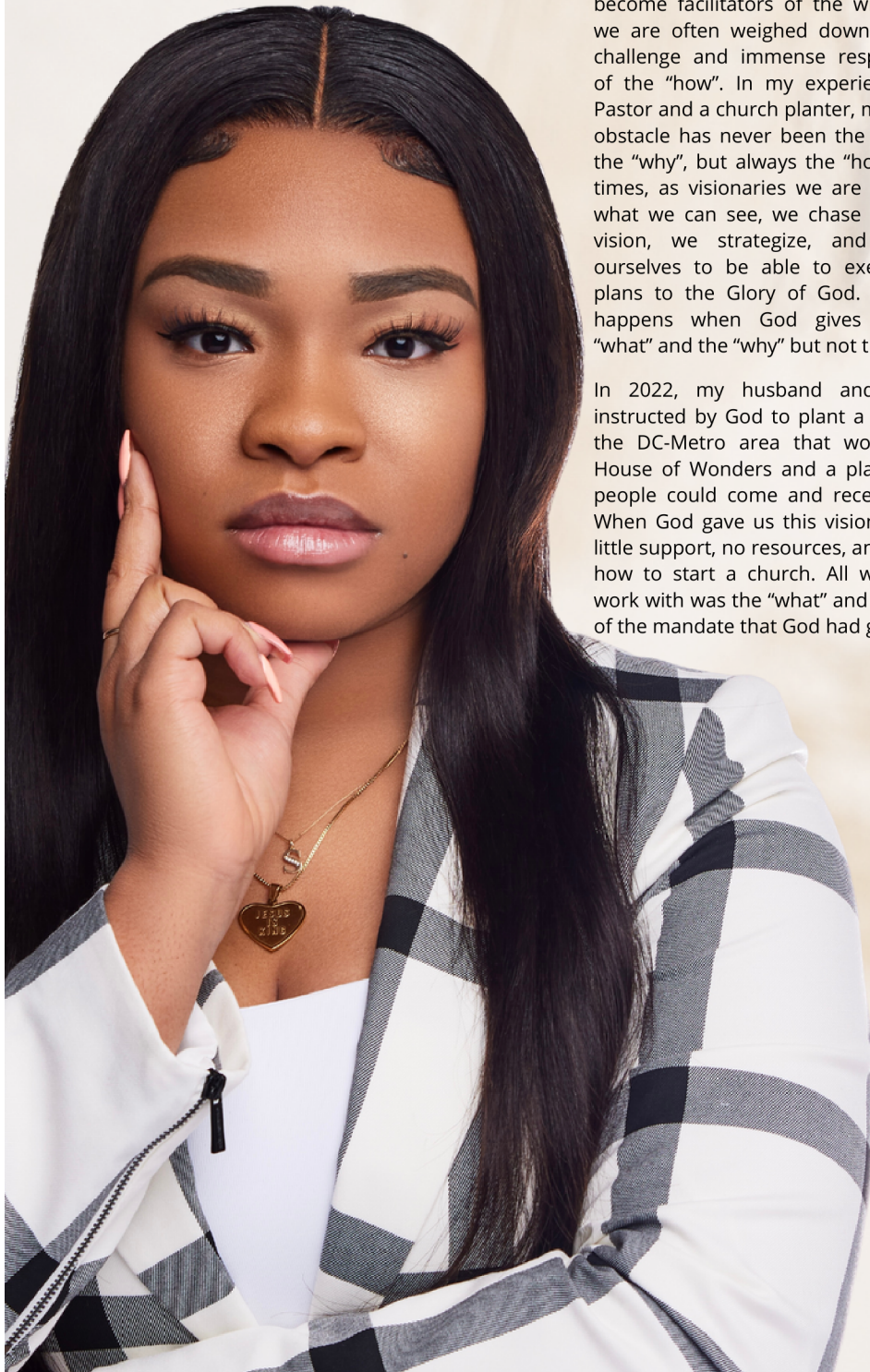
*Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; lean not unto thine own understanding. The word says that we are to detach ourselves from the outcome. This is what "lean not to your own understanding" means. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy path. Be not wise in thine own eyes. Fear the Lord and depart from evil.*

*We must understand that everything is unfolding for us behind the scenes. Don't fret over the timing or the manner of manifestation, because timing is an illusion! Our focus should not be on the outcome but on trusting in the Lord. When we have faith in the seed, we should envision the thing that the seed will produce, not the seed itself, trusting that God has already brought forth the manifestation of that seed in the future. For example, If I plant seeds for oranges, I'm going to tell my wife we have oranges coming. It doesn't matter whether she sees it or not; I believe in the truth, and the truth is we have oranges coming! We might as well make room for the oranges. Find a place for the oranges because they're coming. The manifestation is on its way—it's just a matter of time!*

# SURRENDERING THE “How” TO GOD

When God calls us to build, the vision He gives us is more often way bigger than anything that we could have imagined for ourselves.

When we make the bold decision to become facilitators of the will of God we are often weighed down with the challenge and immense responsibility of the “how”. In my experience as a Pastor and a church planter, my biggest obstacle has never been the “what” or the “why”, but always the “how”. Many times, as visionaries we are driven by what we can see, we chase after that vision, we strategize, and position ourselves to be able to execute our plans to the Glory of God. But what happens when God gives you the “what” and the “why” but not the “how”?

In 2022, my husband and I were instructed by God to plant a church in the DC-Metro area that would be a House of Wonders and a place where people could come and receive Jesus. When God gave us this vision, we had little support, no resources, and no idea how to start a church. All we had to work with was the “what” and the “why” of the mandate that God had given us.

My biggest struggle in the infancy stages of our launching process was trying to figure out how we were going to sustain such a major endeavor. In my mind, doing something as major as a church required resources that we just didn't have at that time. I remember being so overwhelmed with the concerns and worries of the future of our church. I wanted so badly to succeed in the assignment God had given us that for a season I carried the church on my back to the point of exhaustion. I thought that I had to do everything myself if I was going to realize the vision that God showed me. It wasn't until one day while in prayer, I was expressing to the Lord that I needed Him to show me how to take our church to where it needed to be, and in that same moment, the Lord spoke to me very clearly. He said, “The HOW is none of your business”, I didn't understand what He meant at first but after meditating on His words to me, I understood the revelation.

My weakness as a leader was that I needed to have all the answers, and the truth is when you are following the Lord Jesus, you don't always have that luxury. I had to learn that my obedience to God was not dependent on knowing what was ahead of me, it was dependent on my ability to know His voice and follow even when I didn't have the details. We officially launched Gifted Church DMV in 2023, and now almost a year later we are growing and thriving, and if I told you that I understood how we made it this far, I wouldn't be telling the truth. I don't understand how we made it this far, I don't understand why God chose us to shepherd such amazing people. When God gives us a vision, He always points us toward something that is way bigger than us, although you may not have everything now, it is not your job to figure out the “how”.

A God-given vision requires God's supernatural provision. Don't overwhelm yourself with the details, remain faithful and watch all things work together for your good.

# UNVEILING PROPHETIC ENTREPRENEURSHIP:

EMPOWERING BELIEVERS AND TRANSFORMING  
THE MARKETPLACE

It took over a decade and a half to realize that business without divine guidance is like driving to a desired destination without a map. You can't avoid wrong turns, cliffs, or accidents, they're inevitable. You can have the passion to get somewhere, but without direction, it will cause unnecessary disappointment and delay. Revelation hit in my thirties, after I'd "invested" a quarter of a million dollars of my personal funds, and participated in the 24/7 hustle for seven years. I was edging toward suicide, and the love of our great Father caught me up for three days as I'd finally gotten to the end of myself. In a moment of deep surrender, I signed a contract with God that day. He finally owned and operated 100% equity in every desire, every aspiration, and every business.

I left NYC after two decades and was led back to Indiana, where the Lord in His loving kindness said, "Study the word as you study for a test because you will face tests in life." Insert the mindblown emoji, so revelatory and yet so simple. I said out loud, "You could have told me that 20 years ago, Lord." However, the reality was, even amidst growing up in the church as a Pastor's kid, it wasn't until that divine encounter that I sought out direction.

In His grace, He will let you get to the absolute end of yourself and sometimes we have to get fed up with ourselves before we are ready to get truly fed by Him. Fast forward to today, that encounter produced a potent force for transformation in my (faith+work+life) and began my journey of conceiving a new way of work, a term I have coined prophetic entrepreneurship. As a Kingdom entrepreneur walking in the prophetic, I am compelled to explain the necessity of the convergence of prophetic insight and our entrepreneurial endeavors. My desire of uncovering this way of business is in hopes that your hunger to walk in your gifting of the prophetic in the marketplace would increase and materialize.

The prophetic is every believer's gift, especially in this time, it's confirmed in Joel 2:28, "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions."



No believer is exempt, the sons and daughters of God prophesy.

The term "prophetic" derives from the Greek word "prophētikos," which denotes the ability to receive and communicate divine revelation, insight, and guidance. It encompasses a range of spiritual gifts, including prophecy, word of knowledge, word of wisdom, and discerning of spirits (1 Corinthians 12:7-11). Entrepreneurs operate within the realm of vision and innovation, identifying needs and creating solutions to meet them. They possess a keen sense of foresight, recognizing opportunities amidst challenges and mobilizing resources to capitalize on them. Entrepreneurs are agents of change, shaping economies, influencing cultures, and impacting lives through their ventures.

Unifying the two to compose prophetic entrepreneurship transcends and confronts the conventional ways and business models of society. Acknowledging the sheer necessity of divine revelation and supernatural empowerment with entrepreneurial acumen. Prophetic entrepreneurship intertwines insight, foresight, and vision with the practicalities of commerce, birthing a new era of Kingdom business that is inspired by the prosperity, ingenuity, and power of the Holy Spirit.

At its core, the essence of prophetic entrepreneurship is to support believers, reach non-believers, and adhere to divine guidance in navigating the landscape of business so that in fact we would prosper, number our days on earth, apply our hearts to His wisdom and watch the Lord confirm and establish the work of our hands (Psalm 90). Our God wants to establish His work and His vision in His people, and He will confirm it. His blessing will enrich us and He adds no sorrow to it (Proverbs 10:22). We must pay attention, and encourage and nurture our prophetic gifting listening for insight for our business ventures and for our fellow business people. People's freedom and their souls depend on our boldness in the boardroom.

I am captivated by Paul's articulation of how their entrepreneurial endeavors facilitated their ministry, enabling them to focus solely on preaching, praying, prophesying, healing, and delivering without any material need. Paul reminds the church in 1 Thessalonians 2:9

(paraphrased), "Don't forget we work hard among you. Night and day we have worked to earn money so that we aren't a burden to any of you and we can just preach the good news." He essentially said, "Look we've been building tents, we love you and we are financially stable, you can see our hard work and success, now let's get down to the real business, your salvation."

We are laboring among our fellow laborers, yet the issue is the laborers are few because the laborers aren't prepared. We have to prepare the laborers and when you are walking through the doors of offices, small businesses, Fortune 500 companies, and the like, you've got an advantage that your local Pastor might not have, access and acuity in your approach. You carry the Spirit of God within you! What is stopping you from prophesying?! It's not just for Sunday's or your small group. Your life is a ministry, pulpits don't pre-qualify you to preach, pray, prophesy, heal, or deliver. You were qualified the minute you said yes to Jesus. Don't let that drop in your spirit about Jerry's grandmother pass you by, don't hesitate to act on it and be the vessel that allows God to do what only He can do – drawing the hearts of men and women to Him.

As believers, our mandate extends beyond mere profitability; it encompasses our ability to pioneer creative evangelism and exclude examples of His power in the earth and in this case in the office, in the boardrooms, and in the bodegas. As a Kingdom entrepreneur the fingerprint of God should be evident in every transaction and interaction you have within the marketplace, you in fact will be the only Jesus some business professionals ever experience.

We have an opportunity to stand as beacons of light in the marketplace, beckoning believers to walk in their God-given talents while extending an invitation to non-believers to encounter the transformative power of the Gospel. The divine synergy of prophetic entrepreneurship is birthing a paradigm where believers can engage in the marketplace not only to prosper but to also fulfill a higher calling – manifesting the Kingdom of God on earth. Just as Jesus engaged the Samaritan woman at the well (John 4:1-42), prophetic entrepreneurs have the opportunity to encounter individuals in the marketplace, offering them the living water that satisfies the deepest longings of their souls.
