PROTECTYOUR VISION FROM DISCORTANE by Chaplain Dr. Euvonka Farabee



ave you ever

so excited about a business or ministry idea that you could not wait to share your excitement, and details, with someone in your family, or, a close friend? You hoped they would share vour enthusiasm, but instead, you were met with apathy, doubt, or major "You've discouragement: never done something like that before. How do you expect to pull it off?" "That is going to cost millions of dollars. Why don't you come up with something more realistic?" "No one has ever done that before. It will never work." "Didn't you learn your lesson with that last business you tried? Why don't you see if you can get promoted on your job so that you can e stable money that ANOINTING OIL

If you've ever shared your heart with people who are important to you, and were met with these responses, or similar ones, you are not alone. Sharing your vision with the wrong crowd can knock the wind out of your sails. It is common to misjudge the readiness of the people we care for because our love for them can cloud our line of sight to discern where they are in their mental, emotional and spiritual maturity.

Although, it is possible that there are individuals who might be jealous or envious of what you carry as a visionary and a leader, and want to interfere with your progress, I tend to find that many that speak death to your hopes and dreams don't want to hurt you.

They simply have limiting beliefs and a narrow world view that blocks their ability to see beyond what is necessary to achieve greatness, not only for you, but for themselves. It is not personal. They just haven't done the work, yet. Their lack of intent does not change the fact that their vocalized unbelief can be detrimental to your progress, if you are not careful.

Practice discussing your vision with those who need to know, and no one else. Who needs to know? When you think about this, you will probably find that the list is very short, and it is typically comprised of entrepreneurial and life coaches. instructors, mentors, a knowledgeable and trustworthy friend, or two, and someone who to knows how confidentiality get a prayer through.

PRAYER SHAWLS

As you walk out the vision, this list will conservatively expand to include people who are directly involved with carrying the dream forward.

During this season, you might learn that a person in which you have shared your details and processes, is not as ready as you thought. Maybe they don't understand the need for the sacrifices that you are making ... or how long it should be taking. Maybe they don't possess the mindset adequately required to along support you your journey.

Whatever the reason, don't internalize their sentiments. People can't give you what they don't have. Don't initiate discussions regarding your plans in the future. If they do, thank them for their interest in your updates and generalize your responses.



Procrastinating is when you don't do things that you need to get done.

When you procrastinate you end up losing sleep, not remembering things, you fall behind, your grades drop, you get into more trouble and you begin to lose privileges, phone, iPad, TV, or games. "Procrastinating is when you don't do things that you need to get done."

Levels of procrastination 1. Non-procrastinator - does work every day, everything is organized at school, at home, and in their 2. The night before procrastinator backpacks. crams all their homework into one night and study for the test. Start to panic, get angry, and rushes. 3. The day of procrastinator - wake up with anxiety breathing hard. They are irritated and search the internet or ask a friend to use their work, cheat or copy word for word what someone else said, and turn their work in. Work is sloppy and if you have a test you end up looking at others' papers for answers or having a cheat sheet. 4. Super Slacker procrastinator hasn't done anything for a couple of weeks. Homework piles up and gets stuffed and balled up into a backpack. No organization feels pressure and anxiety. Ask others all the time to copy their answers, and cheat on tests.

People will often procrastinate because they have multiple things to do and it seems to be overwhelming or like they can't do everything. Some people may see things as too hard, not fun, boring, or stressful. When you don't feel like you can do something it can make you feel bad about yourself or even feel low about yourself but it's all in your mind. Remember the truth, you have the mind of Christ and you can do all things through Christ who strengthens you.

ways to stop procrastinating:

1. Make a list of your assignments, projects, and test for each class.

Habakkuk 2:2

- Set deadlines and put what's due 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc...
- This helps get everything out of your head on paper and lowers the pressure and nervous feeling you get.

2. Put everything on a planner or calendar.

- 1 Corinthians 14:40.
 - Check it daily to keep up with work.
 - This will help organize everything and you have a visual of what to do.

3. Create a schedule for each assignment.

Luke 14:28

- Get started on assignments, projects, or studies right away
- Do a little bit each day this helps keep information stored in your mind so you are ready for that test and get your work done a lot sooner

4. Take frequent breaks.

Matthew 11:28-30

- Take a 5-10 min break after 30-45 min of doing your work or studies
- This will help you stay focused, get less tired, and not get distracted and stop doing your work.
- 5. Reward yourself.
